















Main Job Separations - Persistent Nonemployment Spell (Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (1 of 2) Sex=Male




Main Job Separations - Persistent Nonemployment Spell (Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (2 of 2) Sex=Female










AQ Separations - Short Duration Nonemployment Spell (Seasonally Adjusted) by Sex and Education (1 of 2) Sex=Male
